### **About this Guide**

This Guide has been produced as part of a project by Green Point Foreshore Reserve Landcare Group, supported by Lake Macquarie City Council through its Environmental Sustainability Grants Program. It has been compiled in good faith but not all identifications have been confirmed so it should not be relied upon. Scientific names used are as per the Australian Orchid Name Index. If you see additional species within Green Point Foreshore Reserve please contact Landcare Resource Centre on 4921 0392 with details on location and photos.

The orchid species are arranged based on dominant flower colours to allow for easy reference (see coloured tabs). Scientific names are given with commonly used synonyms in brackets beside these.

An easy-reference list showing flowering times of the orchids included in this Guide can be located at the back, along with indexes (listed by common and scientific names).



#### Collect photos not samples!

All native orchids are protected by law and collection licences are required for any collection of samples. Furthermore, many of these species are extremely fragile and some are threatened, so please take only photographs!

## Glossary

calli - non-secreting glands.

lateral sepals


callus - a raised, fleshy or plate-like structure found on the labellum; it may have ridges or calli.

column - the central fleshy structure in orchid flowers composed of the style and staminal filaments

labellum - a lip; in orchids and gingers the highly modified ventral petal that is primarily involved in pollination.

perianth - a collective term for the petals and sepals of a flower, in orchids this does not include the labellum.

**sepal** - outer whorl of the perianth (flowering parts).

## Green Point Foreshore Reserve

Green Point Foreshore Reserve (GPFR) is a 152ha site containing a wide range of plant communities, including three Endangered Ecological Communities (EECs) and a SEPP 26 Littoral Rainforest, supporting a variety of threatened species including the Powerful Owl, Squirrel Glider and flowering plant *Tetratheca juncea*.

So far over 35 species of orchids have been identified within the Reserve. Most of these occur on the ridges and drier areas of the Reserve in Eucalypt dominated communities. Most are terrestrial (found on the ground) but some are epiphytic (attaching to trees) or lithophytic (attaching to rocks).

A significant threat to orchids in GPFR is damage by illegal track making, especially by mountain bike riders, so please stick to designated tracks.



Common name: Brown Beaks

Scientific name: Lyperanthus suaveolens

Flowering time: August - September

Distinguishing features:

• Dark brown or yellow to reddish flowers

• End of lip bright yellow

To 45cm tall



Common name: Tiger Orchid
Scientific name: Diuris sulphurea
Flowering time: October - December

Distinguishing features:

• Bright yellow with two prominent maroon spots

Long lateral sepals



Common name: Climbing Orchid

Scientific name: *Erythrorchis cassythoides*Flowering time: September - December

#### **Distinguishing features:**

• Leafless terrestrial orchid

• Attaches wiry climbing stems to host

• Clusters of 20-80 fragrant flowers, each about 2.5cm

across



Common name: Large Tongue

Scientific name: Cryptostylis subulata

Flowering time: October - March

#### **Distinguishing features:**

• Tubular yellow and reddish-brown flowers to 3cm long

• Blackish lobed callus towards apex

• Pollinated by male Ichneumon wasps as they attempt to

mate with the lip



Common name: Maroonhood

Scientific name: Pterostylis pedunculata

Flowering time: July - November

Distinguishing features:

To 25cm tall

• Dark reddish-brown towards front of flower



Common name: Honey Caps

Scientific name: Stegostyla testacea syn. Caladenia testacea

Flowering time: September - November

**Distinguishing features:** 

Pale greenish yellow flowers becoming brown at the tips

Very small flowers with petals less than 1cm long

Labellum white and purple tipped with toothed margins



Common name: Fringed Helmet

Scientific name: Corysanthes fimbriata syn. Corybas fimbriatus

Flowering time: April - July Distinguishing features:

Dark red blotches

• Long narrow teeth on labellum margins



Common name: Spurred Helmet

Scientific name: Corybas aconitiflorus

Flowering time: April - July Distinguishing features:

Two prominent spur spikes on end of lip

• Greyish-maroon flower to 1.5cm long




Common name: Toothed Helmet

Scientific name: Corysanthes pruinosa syn. Corybas pruinosus

Flowering time: April - July Distinguishing features:

Mostly white helmet with few red marks

• Labellum margin with long narrow teeth



Common name: Copper Beard

Scientific name: Calochilus campestris
Flowering time: September - January

Distinguishing features:

• Shiny purple-blue plates at base of labellum



Common name: Purplish Beard

Scientific name: Calochilus robertsonii
Flowering time: September - October

Distinguishing features:

• Prominent 'eye' spots at flower centre

Purplish-red beard



Common name: Red Beard

Scientific name: Calochilus paludosus
Flowering time: September - November

#### **Distinguishing features:**

• Long ribbony tip on end of labellum

Reddish beard with green visible through shorter calli

No eye spots



Common name: Ant Orchid


Scientific name: Myrmechila formicifera syn. Chiloglottis

formicifera

Flowering time: August - September

Distinguishing features:

• Small, black calli extend in narrow strip to end of labellum




**Common name:** Common Wasp **Scientific name:** *Chiloglottis diphylla* 

Flowering time: February - May

Distinguishing features:

• Labellum curved at sides

Lateral sepals long and straight at bottom



Common name: Broad-lip Bird

Scientific name: Myrmechila trapeziformis syn. Chiloglottis

trapeziformis

Flowering time: August - October

Distinguishing features:

Small, black calli restricted to labellum base



Common name: Slender Onion
Scientific name: Microtis parviflora

Flowering time: September - December

#### **Distinguishing features:**

Onion-like leaf

To 35cm long

• Small (0.3cm across) green flowers with smooth-edged

lips



Common name: Snake Orchid
Scientific name: Cymbidium suave
Flowering time: October - December

Distinguishing features:

Epiphytic

Strappy leaves

Green to yellow fragrant flowers



Common name: Nodding Greenhood Scientific name: Pterostylis nutans Flowering time: April - August

Distinguishing features:

Strongly curved hood

Lateral sepal free points extended past hood

Greater than 18mm across hood



Common name: King Greenhood
Scientific name: Pterostylis baptistii
Flowering time: August - October

Distinguishing features:

• Broad and large hood 6cm x 2.5cm

• Green and white with brown towards apex



**Common name:** Sharp Greenhood **Scientific name:** *Pterostylis acuminata* 

Flowering time: March - May Distinguishing features:

Long and sharply pointed labellum sticking out

• Green and white with brown towards apex



Common name: Blunt Greenhood Scientific name: *Pterostylis curta* Flowering time: June - September

#### Distinguishing features:

• The end of the labellum is twisted to one side

• 30cm tall with 3.5cm long flower



Common name: Tall Greenhood

Scientific name: Bunochilus longifolius syn. Pterostylis

longifolia

Flowering time: April - November

**Distinguishing features:** 

Multi-flowered to 40cm tall

Tapered brownish and furry labellum with dark central

stripe



Common name: Blunt-tongue Greenhood

Scientific name: Diplodium obtusum syn. Pterostylis obtusa

Flowering time: February - June

**Distinguishing features:** 

Translucent white flowers with green markings

Blunt labellum tip just visible inside flower



Common name: Trim Greenhood

Scientific name: Taurantha concinna syn. Pterostylis concinna

Flowering time: May - September

Distinguishing features:

Green to cream to brown flower 1.5cm long

• End of the labellum is forked



Common name: Pixie Caps

Scientific name: Acianthus fornicatus

Flowering time: May - August

**Distinguishing features:** 

Heart-shaped leaf - dark green above and maroon below

• Pinkish or reddish hooded flowers (10-14mm long) with

warty labellum

Up to 30cm tall




Common name: Mosquito Orchid Scientific name: Acianthus pusillus Flowering time: March - August

#### **Distinguishing features:**

Heart-shaped leaf - dark green above and maroon below

• Flowers 8–12 mm long, dull green to dull pink

Up to 18cm tall



Common name: Dark Mosquito

Scientific name: Acianthus exsertus

Flowering time: March - April

**Distinguishing features:** 

• Pinkish or purplish well-spaced flowers, 12-16cm long

Red central stripe along dorsal sepal



Common name: Tongue Orchid

Scientific name: Dockrillia linguiformis syn Dendrobium

linguiforme

Flowering time: September - October

Distinguishing features:

Lithophytic or epiphytic

White flowers with narrow segments

Tongue-shaped fleshy leaves



Common name: Ironbark Orchid

Scientific name: Tropilis aemula syn Dendrobium aemulum

Flowering time: July - October

#### Distinguishing features:

• Epiphytic

• White or cream flowers aging to pink

Labellum with pink markings



Common name: White Fingers

Scientific name: Petalochilus catenatus syn. Caladenia

catenata

Flowering time: August - October

**Distinguishing features:** 

White flowers (occasionally flushed pink)

• No dark pink / red anywhere

8-10 teeth on edges



Common name: Pink Fingers

Scientific name: Petalochilus carneus syn. Caladenia carnea

Flowering time: August - October

Distinguishing features:

• Pale pink or sometimes white flowers

• Dark pink / red stripes on labellum

• Lemon tip on end of labellum



Common name: Painted Fingers

Scientific name: Petalochilus pictus syn. Caladenia picta

Flowering time: April - June
Distinguishing features:

Pinkish or white flowers

• Solid red column with no stripes

Flowers in Autumn (where as White Fingers and Pink

Fingers flower in Spring)



Common name: Hyacinth Orchid/ Blotched Hyacinth Orchid

Scientific name: *Dipodium punctatum*Flowering time: November - January

#### **Distinguishing features:**

Pale pink flower with large dark pink blotches

Solid pink flower stalk

Stem dark brown, leafless



Common name: Blotched Hyacinth/ Slender Hyacinth Orchid

Scientific name: *Dipodium variegatum*Flowering time: October - January

#### **Distinguishing features:**

Cream flower heavily blotched with dark pink

• Pink spots extend down the flower stalk

Humped ovary (back of flower)

Stem green, leafless



Common name: Waxlip Orchid
Scientific name: Glossodia major
Flowering time: August - September

### Distinguishing features:

• Mauve or purple flowers 3.5-4.5cm across

• 30cm tall

Base of labellum is white



Common name: Pepper Top Sun

Scientific name: *Thelymitra brevifolia*Flowering time: September - November

#### Distinguishing features:

Small blue- mauve flowers

• Dark brown post-anther lobe (top of column)



Common name: Slender Sun

Scientific name: *Thelymitra pauciflora*Flowering time: September - December

#### Distinguishing features:

To 50cm tall

Purple- pinkish flowers open only in hot weather

Central column has yellow apex



Common name: Blue Caladenia

Scientific name: Cyanicula caerulea syn. Caladenia caerulea

Flowering time: June - August

Distinguishing features:

Blue with pale yellow labellum




